CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIP

Each candidate must be a deserving immediate family member of a Council 2068 Brother Knight or a member in good standing with any of the following churches: St. Andrew's (Waynesboro, PA), St. Rita's (Blue Ridge Summit, PA), or St. Mark's (Greencastle, PA).

A \$2,000 Scholarship will be awarded. Applicants must be a high school senior planning to attend at least a 2-year accredited college program.

The Scholarship will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- a. Church involvement (40%)
- b. Support of community activities (30%)
- c. Extracurricular Activities (10%)
- d. Academic Scholarship (10%)
- e. Son, Daughter, Grandchild of a Council 2068 Knight (10%)

HOW TO PROCEED

In order to compete for a Council 2068, John Itell Knight of Columbus Scholarship you must take four important steps:

1. Complete the application on the next two pages and send it postmarked or delivered to the Scholarship Chairman, (no exceptions) not later than Monday, May 27, 2024 to:

2. You must register and take either the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) of the College Board, or the American College Testing (ACT) Program. To register for these tests, see your guidance counselor. If college you are attending does not require the SAT or ACT you may request a waiver of this requirement
3. Write a letter to the Applications Committee discussing the criteria listed above under the Conditions of the Scholarship section. Tell the committee what you have done to make you the best candidate for this scholarship with particular emphasis on your church involvement.
4. Return with your application a secondary school report that includes your class standing and Official Transcript.

If you are selected as a finalist, you will be notified by phone or email and be required to appear for a personal interview.

Selection of the winning candidates will be made by the Council Scholarship Chairman of Council 2068 and at least two other Council 2068 members.

The \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to the winning candidate and will be paid directly to the college for tuition. Payment will be made about September of 2024.

DEADLINE FOR FILING APPLICATIONS:

Application for this Scholarship must be made on the attached Official Application Form, and must be postmarked or delivered to the Scholarship Chairman on or before May 27, 2024.
